CUBA—Plans are in the making for transfer of the title to the Palmer Opera House from Arts West Gallery to Cuba Friends of Architecture. Arts West Gallery had been awarded \$44,000 in grant money and arrangements have been made to transfer this money to Cuba Friends of Architecture. It is estimated that \$50,000 will still need to be raised to repair the structure's roof. The committee expresses appreciation for support from the community.
